Scholarship Application 2024

Thank you for your interest in the Sankofa Foundation Scholarship provided by the Sankofa Foundation of Dallas/Fort Worth and the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. – Xi Tau Lambda Chapter of North Dallas County.

Scholarships are granted each year to graduating high school African American male seniors. Each student is awarded an individual scholarship of at least \$3,000, payable directly to the student. All application materials are to be sent and postmarked to the following address by March 29, 2024:

Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered. Awardees will be notified no later than May 3, 2024.

In-person interviews will be conducted as part of the scholarship selection process. Applicants who are selected as finalists will be invited for an interview. Interviews will be conducted on **Saturday**, **April 27**, **2024**. Applicants must be available for the interview - please plan accordingly.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 1. Scholarships are limited to African American male graduating seniors attending high schools in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex.
- 2. Preference is given to students who have excelled academically and demonstrated exceptional involvement and service to the community.
- 3. Applicants must have a minimum 2.7 grade point average or better on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. An eligible candidate must be enrolling as a full-time student (at least 12-credit hours) in a 2- or 4-year accredited college or university in the fall semester.
- 5. Applicants must submit a complete scholarship application including all required supporting materials.
- 6. All applications are weighed as follows:

a.	GPA	25%
b.	Essay	30%
c.	Extra-Curricular Activities & Community Service	20%
d.	Letters of Support	10%
e.	Overall Assessment	15%



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Please type all information. The essay should be thoughtfully and clearly written. Application will be rated on appearance, verifiability of information, and evidence of achievements. **Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be considered.**

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: Minimum of \$3,000.00 (Payable upon receipt of college enrollment documentation)
APPLICANT CRITERIA:

- 1. Graduating high school African American male senior
- 2. Minimum GPA 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale) or equivalent
- 3. See cover letter for full details

- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - a. Institutional source (high school letterhead)
 - b. Personal or professional source (on letterhead)
- 5. Senior photograph
